Hello,

We are currently looking to fill an open Board position with Phoenix Children's Hospital's Heart Effect. The appropriate candidate is looking for a non-demanding, volunteer role to offer professional skills and opinions in a fun, positive, and supportive environment.

Board members are required to attend six meetings per year, two of which require live attendance (May and December). There are no meetings held in June or July.

Each Board member will pay dues annually in the amount of \$200 to serve a one-year term beginning in May. The \$200 represents only one-half of the individual tax credit available from the State of Arizona, and any Board member coming to service part way through the year can have dues pro-rated accordingly.

As a philanthropic group, each Board member also has a (flexible) duty to give or get \$5,000 in donations annually.
